2023 Mini Quilt Challenges

Mini Quilt Challenge #1: Due April 4th

1. You must use magenta. (see suggestions below). You can use any other colors in the quilt.
2. The number 23 should be represented in the quilt in some way. For example, you could use 23 pieces, 23 pieces of a certain shape, 23 magenta pieces, etc.
3. Fabrics that are similar to Vive Magenta include Paintbrush Studio Sangria, Free Spirit Solids True Red, paintbrush Studio Cherry Blossom, Michael Miller fuschia (see [The \(not so\) Dramatic Life.com](https://www.thenotso.com))

Mini Quilt Challenge #2: Due April 4th

1. You must use 3 of the 5 colors you are given.
2. You may add light or dark neutrals for a background, and lighter or darker shades of the 3-5 colors from your palette.
3. Your finished quilt can be any size for this challenge.

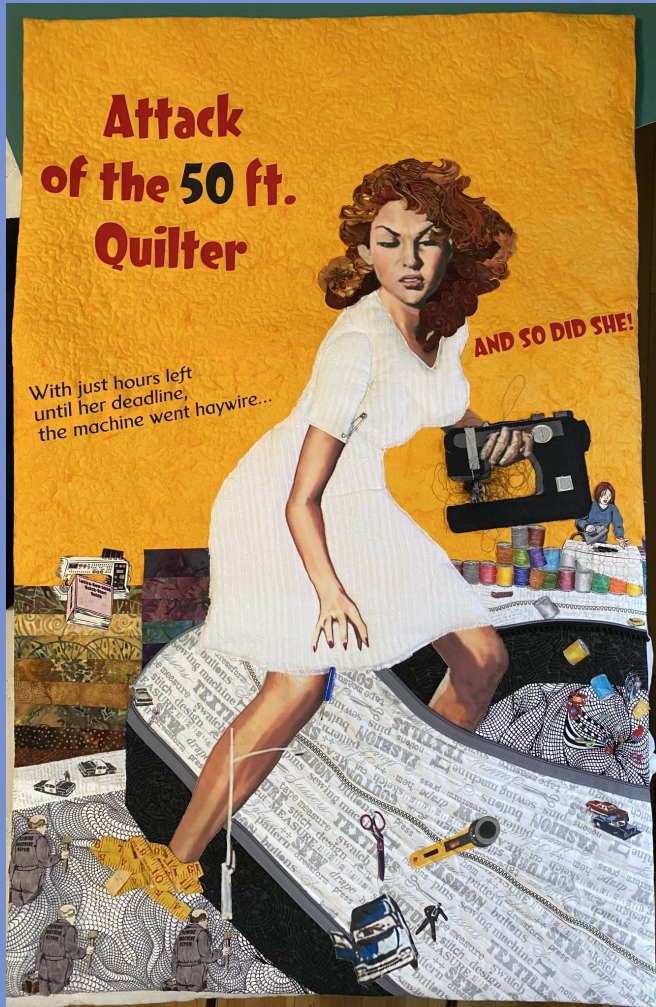

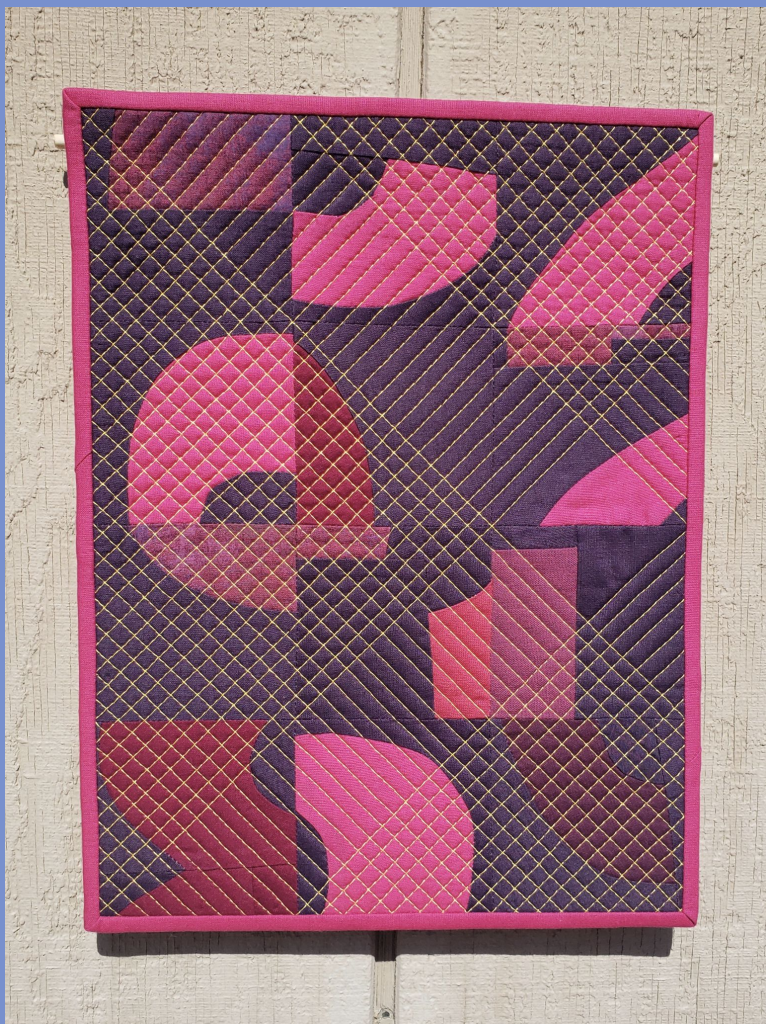
